

THE RAH PRIMARY SCIENCES COURSE 2011

This course will be run over **1 week**, from **08-12th August 2011**, and will cover basic science materials applicable both the JFICM and ANZCA primary examinations.

The primary focus of the course will be the JFICM exam and there will be a session dedicated to the structure and content of this examination, plus some information on fellowship training and examination in intensive care.

The vast majority of the course content will be equally applicable to both primaries and sessions will be predominantly in an **interactive**, “tutorial format”. The program will remain flexible and there will be space within the program for trainees to select topics for later in the week. There will be some trial viva sessions.

Attendees will receive a DVD containing the majority of course content, plus other useful materials. This will be available toward the end of the course week.

Lunch, morning and afternoon tea will be provided at the course venue. Attendees will be free to arrange their evenings. The RAH is close to the “east-end” of Adelaide and there are a wide variety of eating establishments.

Accommodation will be available at all major hotels. Venues and rates will be posted to those who wish to register. Budget accommodation will also be available at the RAH at a nominal cost.
